



Dog Kennels- Basic Cleaning for Same Occupants

Before Starting:

- Have all necessary supplies & equipment present to minimize movement in & out of the designated work area(s)
- Use only none-wood cleaning equipment designated for that specific area
- Confirm protocols, dilutions & contact times for cleaner/disinfectant being used
- Avoid using high pressure (water or air) on potentially contaminated surfaces
- Use new/clean dedicated cleaning cloth for each kennel
- Wear Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) as needed

Protocol:

1. Confine dog(s) to one side of the kennel by closing & securing guillotine door
2. Macro clean:
 - remove any soiled bedding, toys or dirty bowls that will need to be replaced with new items & place in designated enclosed receptacle (i.e. 5-gal buckets-dishes & toys; lined trash can- organic material & debris; solid sided container w/ lid- laundry)
 - for items that will be kept in the kennel that should not get wet gently remove any debris into the trashcan and place on top of none soiled surface within the kennel perimeter (ex: on top of kennel)
 - wash or spray gloved hands with disinfect solution (Repeat for each kennel)
 - scoop feces, hair and debris then dispose of in lined trashcan (Repeat for each kennel)
 - clean scoop, rinse or spray with disinfectant solution & hang up to dry
 - rinse urine down drain w/ low flow stream of water (repeat for each kennel)
- Note:** minimize wetting surfaces as much as possible prior to chemical application
3. Apply cleaner/disinfectant to the inside perimeter & down the center of the kennel floor (Repeat for each kennel)
4. Use dedicated deck brush to spread product evenly across kennel floor, scrub any dried on organic material & all surfaces that previously came in contact w/ the poop scoop
5. Tap brush on kennel floor to dislodge any debris or organic material from the bristles (Repeat for each kennel)
6. Clean deck brush thoroughly, rinse or spray with disinfect solution & hang up to dry
7. Verify required contact time has elapsed
8. Squeegee wet surfaces toward drain & allow to dry
9. Wipe squeegee with designated cloth containing disinfect solution (Repeat for each kennel)
10. Clean squeegee, rinse or spray with disinfect solution & hang up to dry
11. Provide fresh water & food
12. Place additional items (bedding, toys, etc.) back into kennel



13. Wash or spray gloved hands with disinfect solution (Repeat for each kennel)
14. Release dog from confinement and repeat on other-side as needed
15. Remove gloves & wash hands thoroughly

Dog Kennels- Deep Cleaning Between New Occupants

Before Starting:

- Have all necessary supplies & equipment present to minimize movement in & out of the designated work area(s)
- Use only none-wood cleaning equipment designated for that specific area
- Confirm protocols, dilutions & contact times for cleaner/disinfectant being used
- Avoid using high pressure (water or air) on potentially contaminated surfaces
- Use new/clean dedicated cleaning cloth for each kennel
- Wear Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) as needed

Protocol:

1. Macro Clean:
 - remove all bedding, toys, bowls, etc. & place used items in designated enclosed receptacles (i.e. 5-gal buckets-dishes & toys; lined trash can- organic material & debris; solid sided container w/ lid- laundry)
 - prop up items such as trench lids or sleeping platforms to expose underside for cleaning/disinfecting
 - close kennel door (Repeat for each kennel)
2. Apply disinfectant to front of kennel door starting in upper left-hand corner and working left-right/ top-bottom in a 'Z' pattern **Note:** hold applicator close to door to minimize over spray
3. Apply disinfectant to kennel interior starting in the upper front left corner and treating upper, mid-level & ground level perimeters & down the center of the kennel floor **Note:** for kennel doors w/ bars there may already be a significant amount of disinfectant already on the interior surfaces from spraying the cage door-apply additional product only as needed (Repeat for each kennel)
4. Use dedicated deck brush to thoroughly scrub all surfaces including kennel floor, walls, ceiling (top & bottom if applicable) door (inside & out), sleeping platform, drain cover (inside & out)
5. Tap brush on kennel floor to dislodge any debris or organic material from the bristles (Repeat for each kennel)
6. Thoroughly clean deck brush, rinse or spray with disinfect solution & hang up to dry
7. Verify designated contact time has elapsed
8. Thoroughly rinse all surfaces in each kennel
9. Squeegee wet surfaces toward drain & allow to dry (Repeat for each kennel)
10. Clean squeegee thoroughly, rinse or spray with disinfect solution & hang up to dry
11. Remove any miscellaneous readily accessible items such as cage card holders, clipboards, etc. and wipe down with dedicated cleaning cloth & disinfectant, then replace



12. Using the same cloth wipe hard to reach surfaces such as top & underside of kennel door
13. Wash or spray gloved hands with disinfect solution (Repeat for each kennel)
REMEMBER: to use a new cleaning cloth for each kennel
14. Remove gloves & wash hands thoroughly after final kennel

If kennel is going to be occupied immediately:

15. Provide fresh water & food
16. Place additional items (bedding, toys, etc.) into kennel
